The Sundon Landfill Restoration Project aims to restore a previously used landfill to accommodate a country park, with public footpaths, areas of grassland and areas planted with native trees and shrubs.

It is estimated that some 410,000m<sup>3</sup> of restoration soils will be needed to complete the project to the levels specified in the planning permissions.

To date a total of 278,008m<sup>3</sup> of restoration soils have been imported into the project from a total of 297 different locations.

Each site that wishes to deposit soils at Sundon must first submit an enquiry to Storefield's Technical team. The technical team will analyse the testing data provide and make a decision whether the material is suitable for restoration purposes. If the material is deemed suitable, then an authorisation number is allocated to the site and material is allowed to be imported to Sundon.



Regular sampling carried out at Sundon ensures the quality of soils imported remains constant throughout the project. Any abnormalities are dealt with as a non-conformance and are dealt with accordingly.
